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# Jack & Jill Travel Pillow

Fabric Image	SKU	Yardage	Description	Quantity & Size	
	C3270-PINK	5/8 yard if not directional 1 yard if directional	Pillowcase Body	1	16" x 28 1/2" rectangle *
	C3272-AQUA	1/3 yard	Outer Cuff	1	8" x 28 1/2" rectangle
	C3275-GRAY	1/4 yard	Prairie Points	11	3 1/2" squares



\* If fabric is directional, the pillowcase body should be positioned as shown when cut.

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Use ¼" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

## Prairie Points:

With wrong sides facing, fold the 3 ½" squares on the diagonal from corner to corner. Press.

Then fold in half along the long edge. Press.

Repeat ten more times.

Make eleven Prairie Points total.



## Pillowcase Assembly:

Arrange the Prairie Points evenly along the long edge of Outer Cuff, matching raw edges. Prairie Points will overlap slightly.

Pin the Prairie Points to the Outer Cuff as shown.



With right sides facing, layer the Outer Cuff and the Pillowcase Body along the 28 ½" edge. Lay the Pillowcase Body facing to the left, so that it faces up when pillow is complete. Line up raw edges and pin layers together. Do not sew yet.



Roll the Pillowcase Body up from the bottom into a tube until the Outer Cuff is exposed.



Fold up the bottom of the Outer Cuff over the rolled Pillowcase Body so four layers of raw edges are even. Pin together. Stitch all four layers together with a ⅜" seam allowance and backstitch to secure seam.

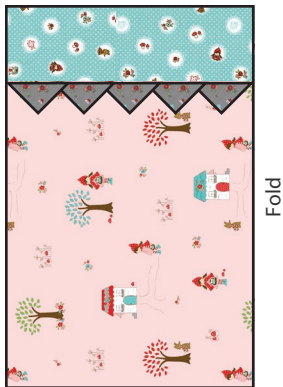


Reach into the fabric tube and pull out the Pillowcase Body. Pillowcase should now have the Outer Cuff sewn with no exposed seams. Press.



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Fold the pillowcase in half lengthwise with the wrong sides together. Pin in place.

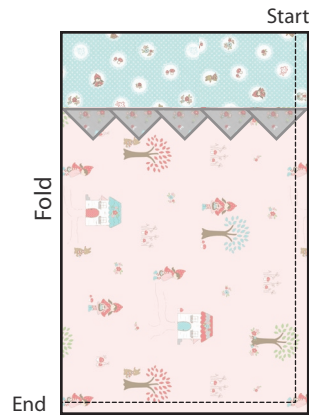


With the pillowcase folded right sides out, stitch along the side and bottom edges of the pillowcase with a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Backstitch at the beginning and end of the seam.



Turn the pillowcase inside out. Flatten the seam and pin along the edge, enclosing the seam.

Sew the same side and bottom seam, with the previous seam enclosed, with a  $\frac{3}{8}$ " seam allowance. Backstitch at beginning and end.



Turn the pillowcase right side out. Pillowcase should measure  $13 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $18 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
