Page 2

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

Big Diamond Blocks:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric A squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric A square with a Fabric I square.

Stitch 1/4" from each side of the drawn line.

Cut apart on the marked line.

Unit should measure 7 1/2" x 7 1/2".

Repeat four more times.

Make ten.



Make ten.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric A square with a Fabric G square.

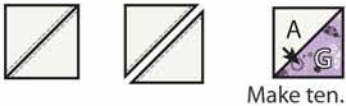
Stitch 1/4" from each side of the drawn line.

Cut apart on the marked line.

Unit should measure 7 1/2" x 7 1/2".

Repeat four more times.

Make ten.

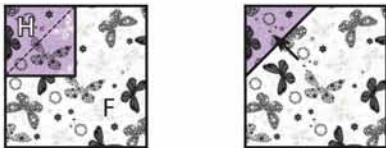


Make ten.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric H and Fabric J squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric H square on the top left corner of the Fabric F square.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.



Make three.

Repeat on the bottom right corner with a Fabric H square and top right and bottom left corner with Fabric J squares.

Unit should measure 14 1/2" x 14 1/2".

Repeat two more times.

Make three.



Make three.

Assemble one Fabric A/I unit and one Fabric A/G unit as shown.

Unit should measure 7 1/2" x 14 1/2".

Repeat three more times.

Make four.



Make four.

Assemble one Fabric A/G unit and one Fabric A/I unit as shown.

Unit should measure 7 1/2" x 14 1/2".

Repeat five more times.

Make six.



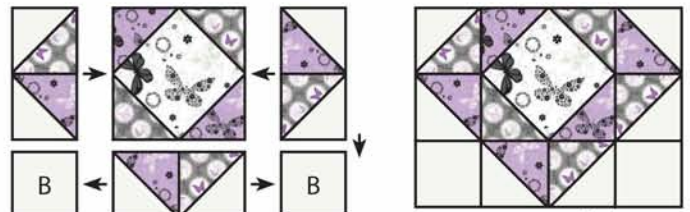
Make six.

Assemble Partial Big Diamond Block as shown.

Partial Big Diamond Block should measure 21 1/2" x 28 1/2".

Repeat one more time.

Make two.

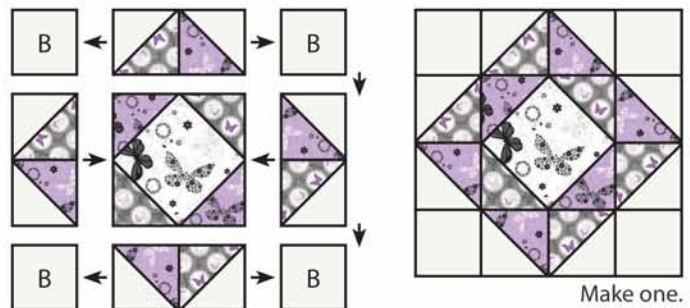

Assemble Full Big Diamond Block as shown.

Full Big Diamond Block should measure 28 1/2" x 28 1/2".

Make one.

Page 3

Small Diamond Blocks:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric C squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric C square with a Fabric O square.

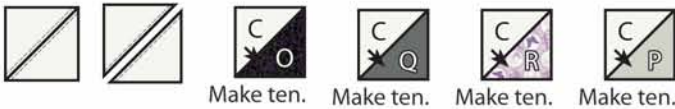
Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the drawn line.

Cut apart on the marked line.

Unit should measure 4" x 4".

Make ten from each Fabric O, Fabric Q, Fabric R and Fabric P.

Make forty total.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric N and Fabric M squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric N square on the top left corner of the Fabric K square.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the bottom right corner with a Fabric N square and top right and bottom left corner with Fabric M squares.

Unit should measure 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Repeat three more times.

Make four.



With right sides facing, layer a Fabric M square on the left end of a Fabric L rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the right end of the Fabric L rectangle with a Fabric N square.

Unit should measure 4" x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Repeat one more time.

Make two.



Assemble one Fabric C/O unit and one Fabric C/P unit as shown.

Unit should measure 4" x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Repeat nine more times.

Make ten.



Assemble one Fabric C/R unit and one Fabric C/Q unit as shown.

Unit should measure 4" x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Repeat seven more times.

Make eight.



Assemble Partial Small Diamond Block as shown.

Partial Small Diamond Block should measure 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Repeat one more time.

Make two.

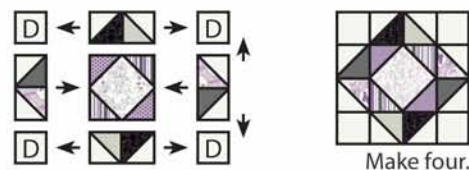


Assemble Full Small Diamond Block as shown.

Full Small Diamond Block should measure 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Repeat three more times.

Make four.

Page 4

Square in a Square Blocks:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric E squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric E square on one corner of a Fabric T square.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Make five.

Repeat on the remaining corners of the Fabric T square.

Square in a Square Block should measure $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make five from each Fabric T and Fabric S.

Make ten total.

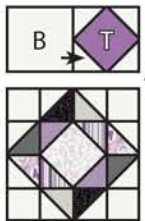

Quilt Center:

Assemble unit as shown.

Unit should measure $14\frac{1}{2}$ " x $21\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make one.

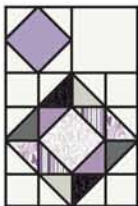
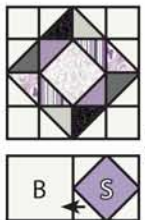

Make one.



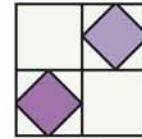
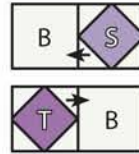

Make four.

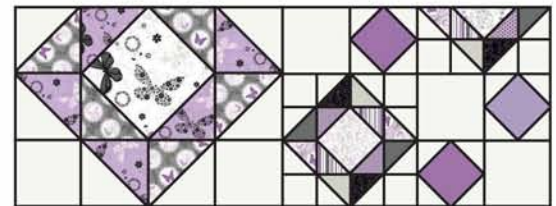
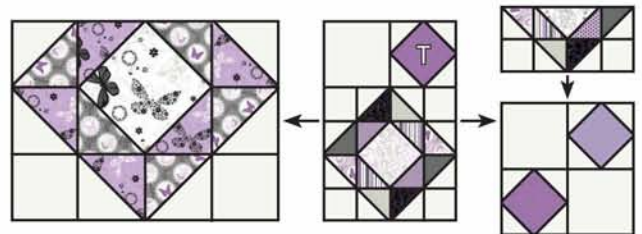


Make four.

Quilt Row One should measure $21\frac{1}{2}$ " x $56\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make one.

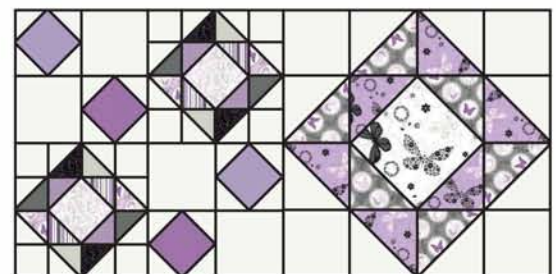
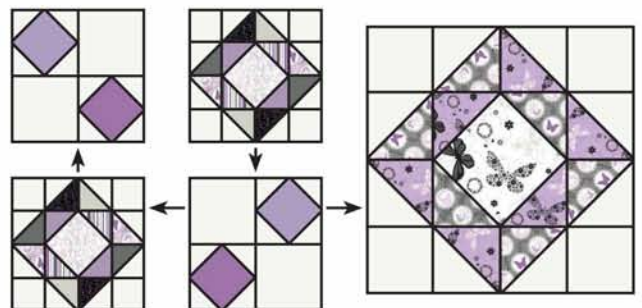


Make one.

Quilt Row Two should measure $28\frac{1}{2}$ " x $56\frac{1}{2}$ ".

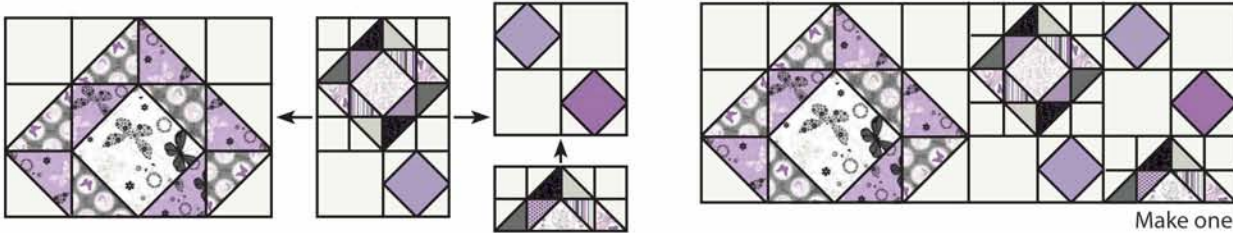

Page 5

Assemble Quilt Row Three as shown.

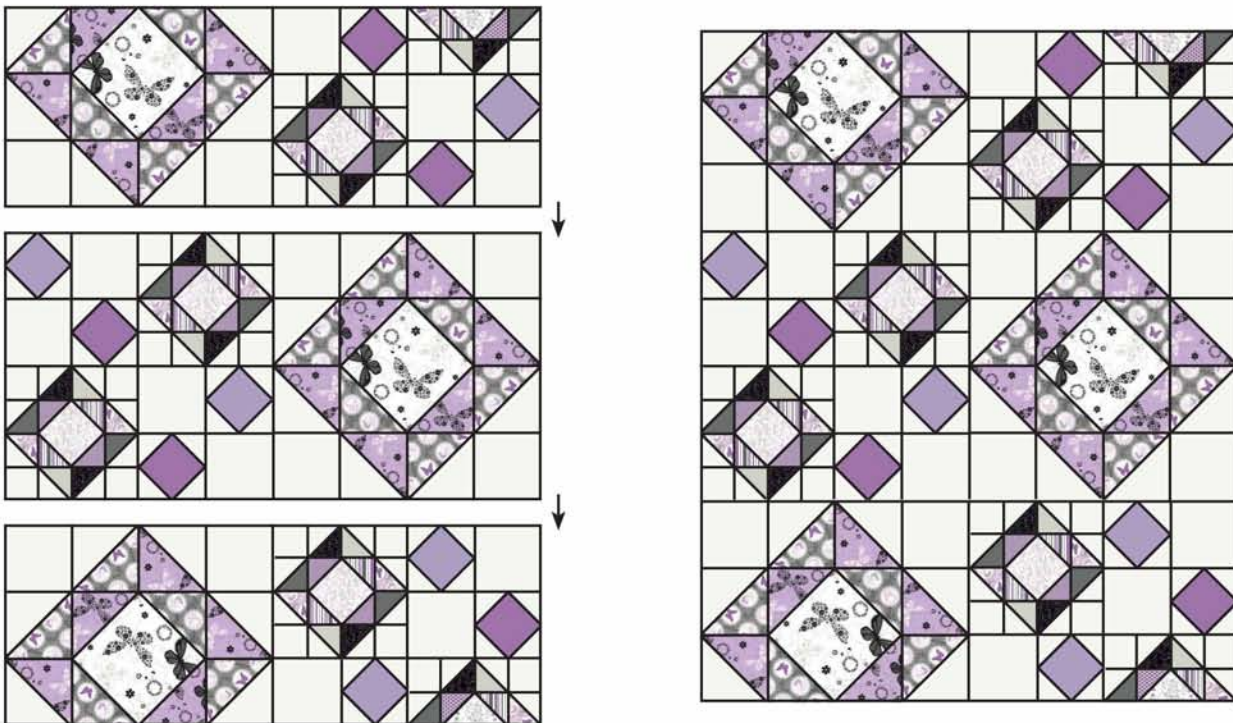
Quilt Row Three should measure 21 1/2" x 56 1/2".

Make one.



Assemble Quilt Center as shown.

Quilt Center should measure 56 1/2" x 70 1/2".



Finishing:

Piece Fabric U strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.
