
# GG Squared Companion Sheet (Mama's Crochet Quilt)

## Download One - Filled Basket Block

#### **Cutting Instructions:** From 1/3 yard of white background fabric: Fabric B - Cut 2 Fabric C - Cut 2 Fabric D - Cut 2 Fabric E - Cut 2 Fabric F - Cut 4 Fabric G - Cut 2 Fabric H - Cut 8 Fabric I - Cut 1 2" x 2 1/2" rectangles \* - Cut 2 1 ½" squares \* - Cut 4 1" x 7 1/2" rectangle \* - Cut 1 1" x 4 ½" rectangles \* - Cut 2 From a fat quarter of pink fabric for basket base: Fabric N - Cut 1 Fabric O - Cut 1 From $\frac{1}{8}$ yard of red fabric for basket handle and trim: Fabric P - Cut 1 Fabric Q - Cut 2 Fabric R - Cut 4 Fabric S - Cut 1 From $\frac{1}{8}$ yard of blue fabric for basket bow: Fabric T - Cut 2 Fabric U - Cut 6 Fabric V - Cut 1 From 2 scrappy fabrics for the bottom yarn balls: $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (2 total) \* - Cut 1 From 1 scrappy fabric for the top yarn ball: 2 ½" x 3 ½" rectangle \* - Cut 1 1 1/2" squares \* - Cut 2

Finished Size: 11 1/2" x 15 1/2"

### **GG Squared Companion Sheet (Mama's Crochet Quilt)**

#### Stacked Yarn Unit:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 1 ½" white background squares.

With right sides facing, layer a 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " white background square on the top left corner of the 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " scrappy fabric rectangle for the Top Yarn Unit.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.





Make one

Repeat on the top right corner of the 2 ½" x 3 ½" scrappy fabric rectangle.

Top Yarn Unit should measure 2 ½" x 3 ½".

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 1 ½" scrappy squares.

With right sides facing, layer a 1 ½" white background square on the top left corner of the 2 ½" x 3 ½" scrappy fabric rectangle for the Left Yarn Unit.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.





Make one

Repeat on the top right corner of the 2 ½" x 3 ½" scrappy fabric rectangle with a 1 ½" scrappy square.

Left Yarn Unit should measure 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make one

With right sides facing, layer a 1 ½" scrappy square on the top left corner of the 2 ½" x 3 ½" scrappy fabric rectangle for the Right Yarn Unit.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.





Make one.

Repeat on the top right corner of the 2 ½" x 3 ½" scrappy fabric rectangle with a 1 ½" white background square.

Right Yarn Unit should measure 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ ".






Assemble two 2" x 2 ½" white background rectangles, the Top Yarn Unit, the Left Yarn Unit and the Right Yarn Unit.

Three Yarn Unit should measure 4 ½" x 6 ½".

Make one.








Attach side borders using the 1" x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " white background rectangles.

Attach top border using the 1"  $\times$  7  $\frac{1}{2}$ " white background rectangle.

Stacked Yarn Unit should measure 5" x 7 1/2".
