

## Download Five - Great Granny Quilt Label

Finished Size: 12" x 12"

### Cutting Instructions:

#### From 24 scrappy fabrics:

- Cut 4 Fabric B
- Cut 8 Fabric C
- Cut 12 Fabric D

#### From 1/2 yard of white background fabric:

- Cut 1 Fabric A
- Cut 12 Fabric H
- Cut 4 Fabric I
- Cut 1 12 1/2" square

# GG Squared Companion Sheet (Mama's Crochet Quilt)

## Embroidery:

Trace the letters you need from page 14 on the Baby square.

Using three strands of embroidery floss, sew a backstitch for the lines.

## Label Backing:

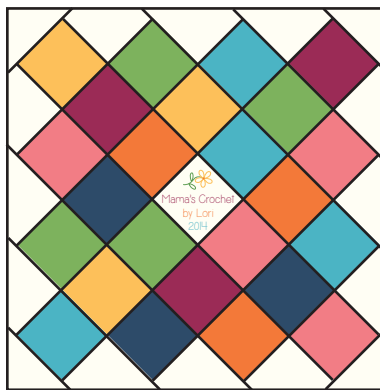
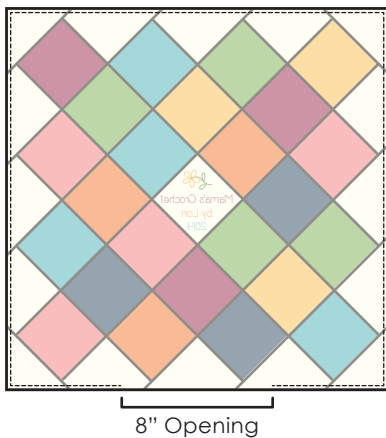
With right sides facing, layer the Great Granny Quilt Label with the 12 ½" white background square.

Stitch around the Great Granny Quilt Label using a ¼" seam. Leave an 8" opening at the bottom.

Turn the Great Granny Quilt Label right side out.

Press the opening edges under ¼" and hand stitch the bottom closed.

Great Granny Quilt Label should measure 12" x 12".



## Attaching the Label:

Pin the Great Granny Quilt Label 10" to 12" from the side and bottom of the Great Granny Squared Sampler backing, leaving plenty of room for the longarm quilter to put it on their longarm frame without bothering the label.

Use a whip stitch to sew the Great Granny Quilt Label to the backing.
