# Red Bird, Blue Skies Quilt Block Tutorial 

Cutting Instructions:


Use $1 / 4$ " seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.
Assemble one Fabric A square and one Fabric D square as shown. Unit should measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat one more time. Make two.


Assemble the two Fabric A/D units as shown. Unit should measure $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make one.


Make one.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric $B$ square.
With right sides facing, layer a Fabric B square with the Fabric E square.
Stitch $1 / 4 "$ from each side of the drawn line.
Cut apart on the marked line.
Half-square triangle units should measure $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make two.


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Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric $F$ square.
With right sides facing, layer a Fabric F square on one corner of a Fabric D square.
Stitch on the drawn line and trim $1 / 4$ " away from the seam.
Unit should measure 2 1/2" $\times 2$ 1/2". Make one.


Assemble the Fabric D/F unit, a Fabric A square and the Fabric C rectangle as shown. Unit should measure $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make one.


Assemble all units as shown. Block should measure 8 $1 / 2$ " square. Make one.


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
