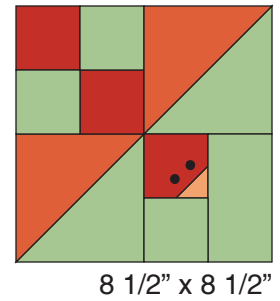
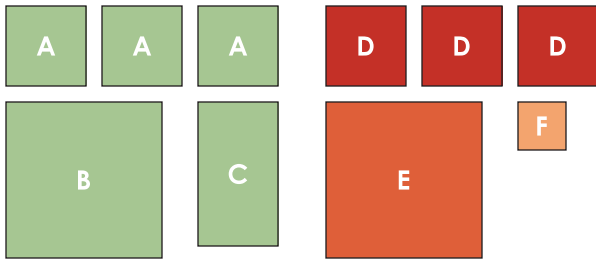


Red Bird, Blue Skies

Quilt Block Tutorial



Cutting Instructions:



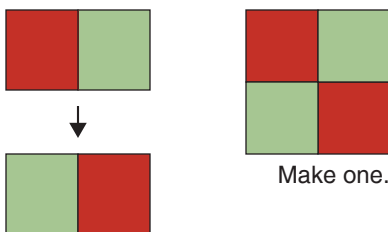
Fabric	Quantity	Size
A	3	2 1/2" squares
B	1	4 7/8" square
C	1	2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle
D	3	2 1/2" squares
E	1	4 7/8" square
F	1	1 1/2" square

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

Assemble one Fabric A square and one Fabric D square as shown. Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 4 1/2". Repeat one more time. Make two.



Assemble the two Fabric A/D units as shown. Unit should measure 4 1/2" square. Make one.



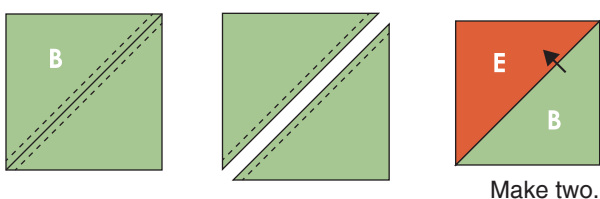
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric B square.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric B square with the Fabric E square.

Stitch 1/4" from each side of the drawn line.

Cut apart on the marked line.

Half-square triangle units should measure 4 1/2" square. Make two.

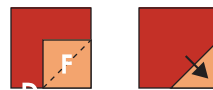


Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric F square.

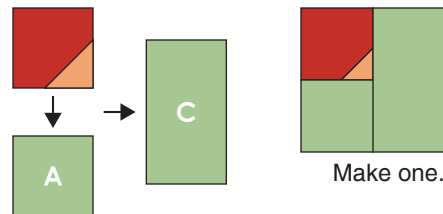
With right sides facing, layer a Fabric F square on one corner of a Fabric D square.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.

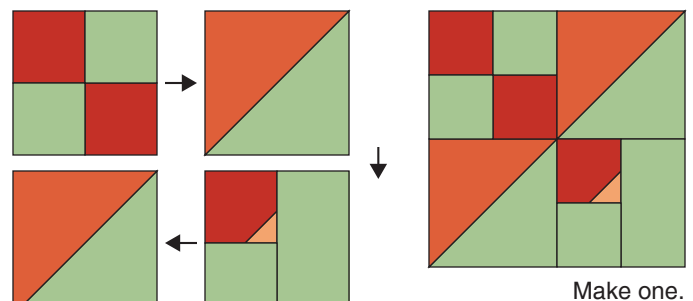
Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 2 1/2". Make one.



Assemble the Fabric D/F unit, a Fabric A square and the Fabric C rectangle as shown. Unit should measure 4 1/2" square. Make one.



Assemble all units as shown. Block should measure 8 1/2" square. Make one.
