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Use ¼" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

Fabrics shown throughout are for the Pink Castle color option. Refer to the fabric requirements for the Blue Castle color option.

CASTLE BLOCK:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric D squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric D square on one end of a Fabric K rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim ¼" away from the seam.



Repeat on the opposite end.

Flying Geese Unit should measure 3" x 5 ½".



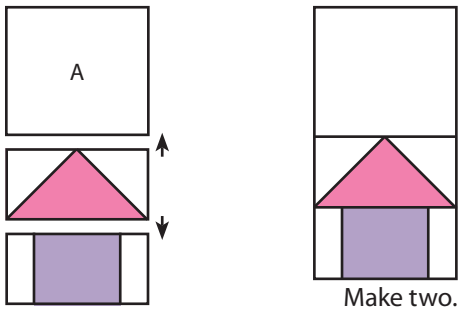
Assemble two Fabric E rectangles and one Fabric R rectangle.

Bottom Mini Tower Unit should measure 3" x 5 ½".



Assemble one Fabric A rectangle, one Flying Geese Unit and one Bottom Mini Tower Unit.

Mini Tower Unit should measure 5 ½" x 10".



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric B squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric B square on one end of the Fabric J rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim ¼" away from the seam.



Repeat on the opposite end.

Large Flying Geese Unit should measure 4" x 7 ½".



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric V squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric V square on the top left corner of the Fabric C rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim ¼" away from the seam.



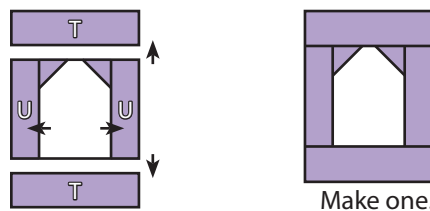
Repeat on the top right corner.

Partial Middle Tower Unit should measure 3" x 4".



Assemble two Fabric U rectangles, the Partial Middle Tower Unit and two Fabric T rectangles.

Middle Tower Unit should measure 5" x 6 ½".

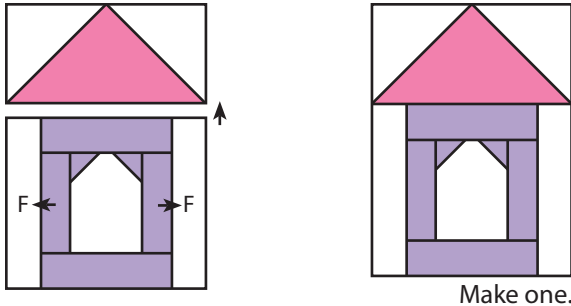


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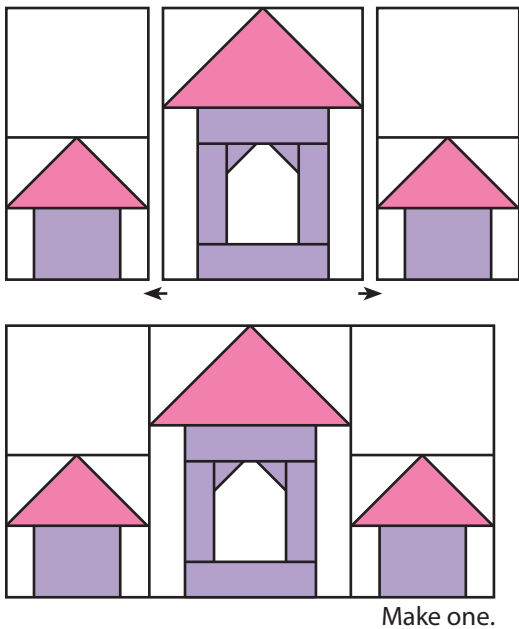
Assemble two Fabric F rectangles, the Middle Tower Unit and the Large Flying Geese Unit.

Tower Unit should measure $7\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10''$.



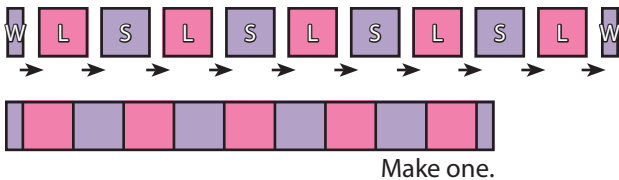
Assemble two Mini Tower Units and the Tower Unit.

Top Castle Unit should measure $10'' \times 17\frac{1}{2}''$.



Assemble two Fabric W rectangles, five Fabric L squares and four Fabric S squares.

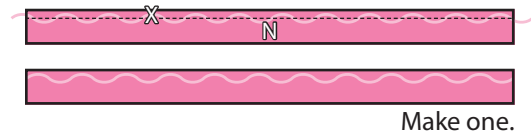
Top Battlement Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{4}'' \times 17\frac{1}{2}''$.



Using a $\frac{1}{8}''$ seam, attach the 20" Ric Rac X strip slightly above the top of the Fabric N rectangle as shown.

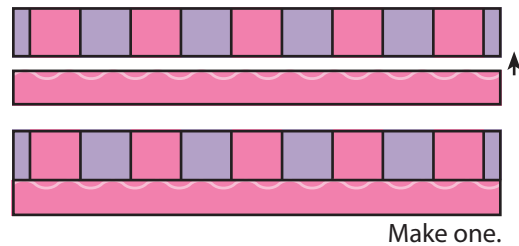
Trim off excess ric rac from the ends.

Rectangle Unit should measure $1\frac{3}{4}'' \times 17\frac{1}{2}''$.



Assemble the Top Battlement Unit and the Rectangle Unit.

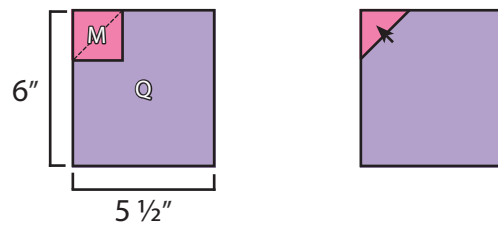
Battlement Unit should measure $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 17\frac{1}{2}''$.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric M squares.

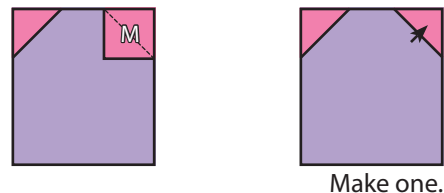
With right sides facing, layer a Fabric M square on the top left corner of the Fabric Q rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}''$ away from the seam.



Repeat on the top right corner.

Door Unit should measure $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6''$.

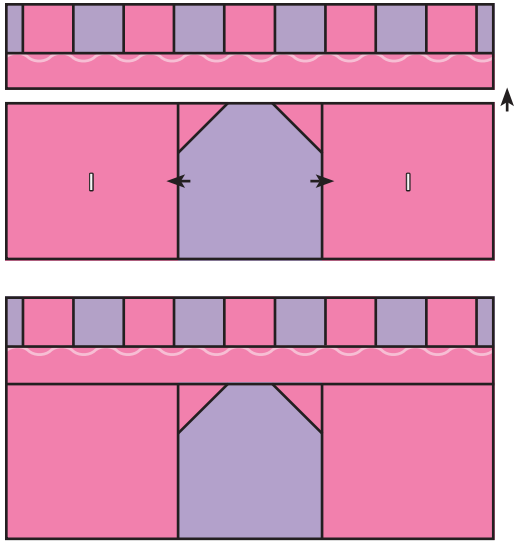


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Assemble two Fabric I rectangles, the Door Unit and the Battlement Unit.

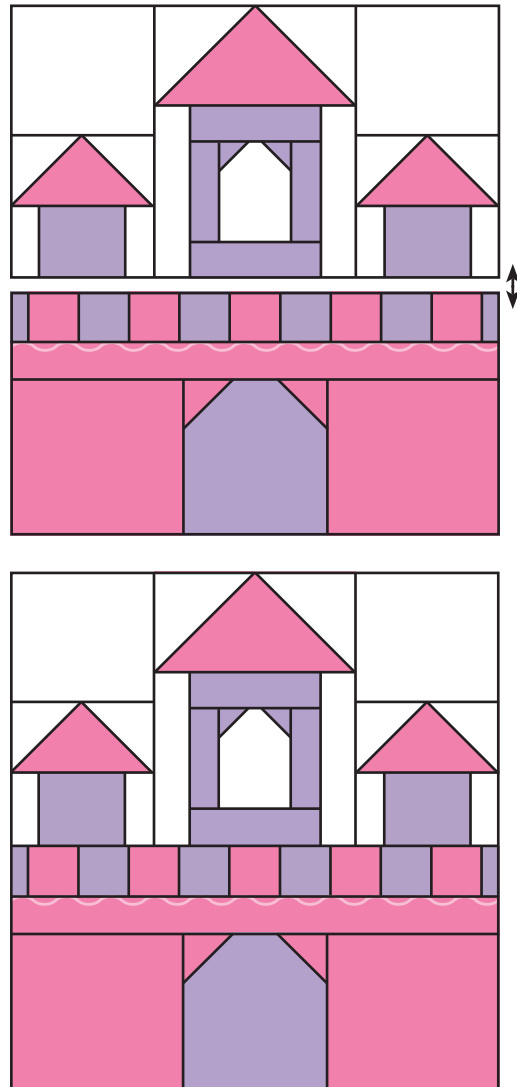
Bottom Castle Unit should measure 9" x 17 1/2".



Make one.

Assemble the Castle Block.

Castle Block should measure 17 1/2" x 18 1/2".



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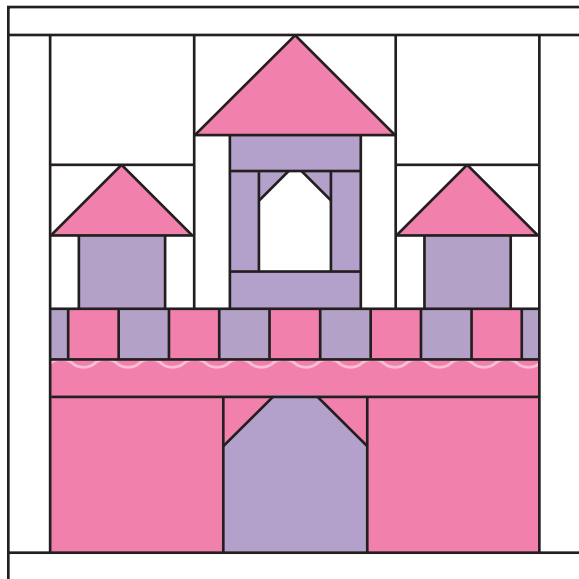
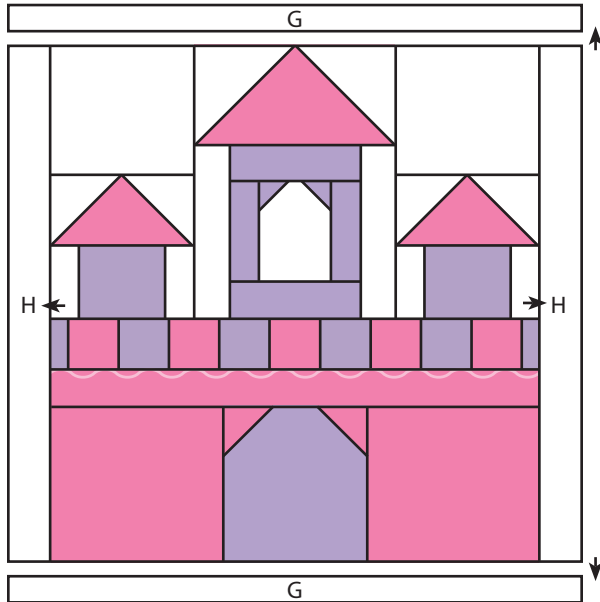
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BORDERS:

Attach side borders using the Fabric H strips.

Attach top and bottom borders using the Fabric G strips.

Pillow Top should measure $20\frac{1}{2}'' \times 20\frac{1}{2}''$.



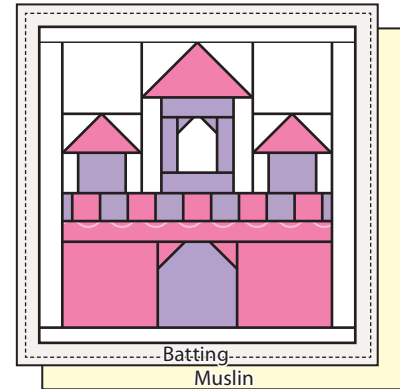
PILLOW TOP:

Layer Pillow Top, Batting and Muslin.

Quilt Pillow Top as desired.

Baste $\frac{1}{8}''$ around outside edges of the Pillow Top.

Trim excess Batting and Muslin.

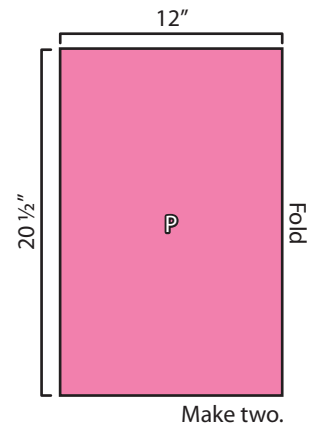


PILLOW BACK:

With wrong sides facing, fold a Fabric P rectangle in half.

Folded Fabric P Unit should measure $12'' \times 20\frac{1}{2}''$.

Make two.



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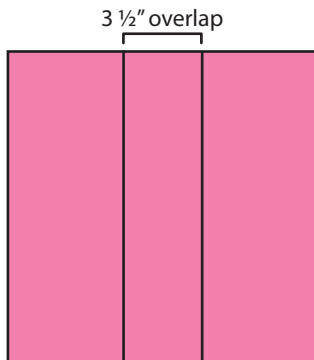
PILLOW ASSEMBLY:

Layer two Folded Fabric P Units and overlap them $3\frac{1}{2}$ " with folds in the center and raw edges on the outside.

Pin around the edges.

Baste $\frac{1}{8}$ " around the edges of the Pillow Back.

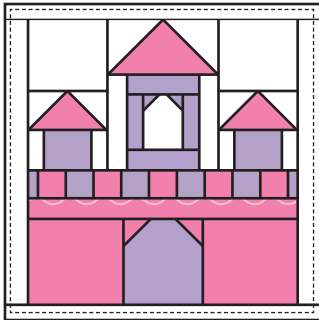
Pillow Back should measure $20\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Mark the center of the Pillow Top and mark the center of the Pillow Back. Matching centers, layer the Pillow Top right side up on the Pillow Back.

Baste $\frac{1}{8}$ " around the edges to hold the Pillow Top and Pillow Back together.

Trim the excess backing.



FINISHING:

Piece the Fabric O strips end to end for binding.

Bind as desired.
