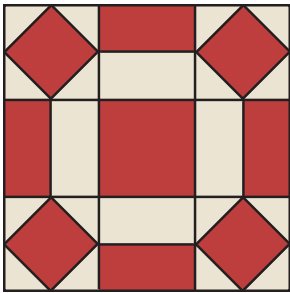


Rolling Stone Quilt Block




Unfinished size: 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".

Cutting Instructions:

One Block	
Red Print	1 - 4 1/2" square (A)
	4 - 4 1/2" squares (B)
	4 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (C)
Background	4 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (D)
	16 - 2 1/2" squares (E)



Pattern for Crib, Lap,
Twin & King size quilt

Sew using a 1/4" seam allowance and press as shown by arrows.

Block Assembly:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric E squares.
With right sides facing, layer a Fabric E square on one corner of a
Fabric B square.
Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.



Make four.

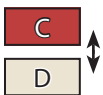
Repeat on the remaining corners of the Fabric B square.
Corner Rolling Stone Unit should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".



Make four.

Assemble one Fabric C rectangle and one Fabric D rectangle.

Middle Rolling Stone Unit should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".



Make four.



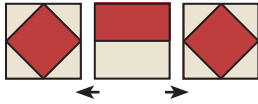
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Rolling Stone Quilt Block

Assemble two Corner Rolling Stone Units and one Middle Rolling Stone Unit.

Outer Rolling Stone Unit should measure $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$.

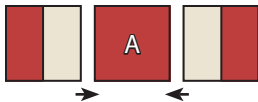

Make two.

Assemble two Middle Rolling Stone Units and the Fabric A square.

Inner Rolling Stone Unit should measure $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$.



Make one.

Assemble the Rolling Stone Block.

Rolling Stone Block should measure $12\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$.
