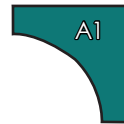
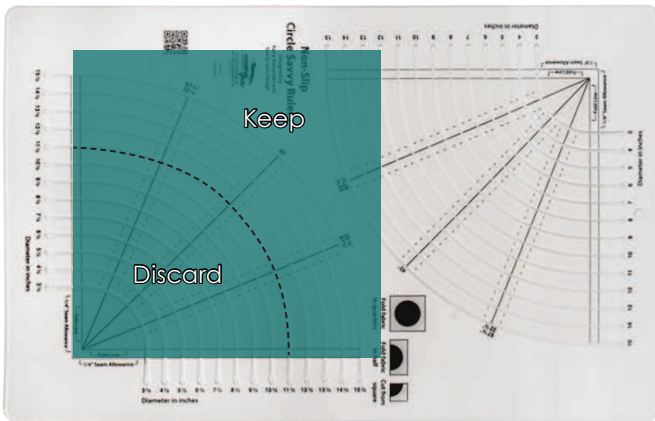
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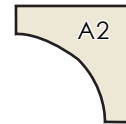
Daybreak Blocks:

Using the 11 1/2" diameter line on the Creative Grids Non-Slip Circle Savvy Ruler, cut the Fabric A squares into Background Units.

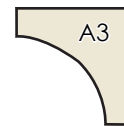
Make twenty Dark Background Units and twenty Light Background Units. Make forty total.



Make twenty
Dark Background Units.



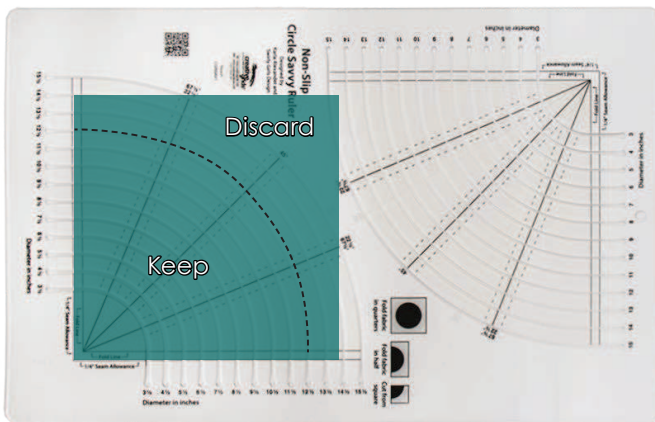
Make twelve
Light Background Units.



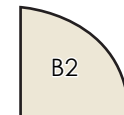
Make eight
Light Background Unit.

Using the 12 1/2" diameter line on the Creative Grids Non-Slip Circle Savvy Ruler, cut the Fabric B squares into Pie Units.

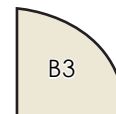
Make sixteen Dark Pie Units and twenty-eight Light Pie Units. Make forty-four total.



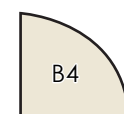
Make sixteen
Dark Pie Units.



Make two
Light Pie Units.



Make twenty
Light Pie Units.



Make six
Light Pie Units.

*If you do not have the Creative Grids Non-Slip Circle Savvy Ruler, templates are provided on pages 8 to 10.

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Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

With right sides facing, layer a Light Background Unit with a Dark Pie Unit. Match centers and pin.

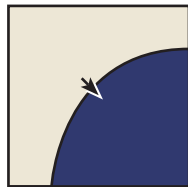
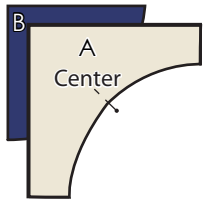
Watch our YouTube tutorial for close instructions.

With the Pie Section on the bottom, stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the edge of the Light Background Unit. Be careful when stretching the bias edges.

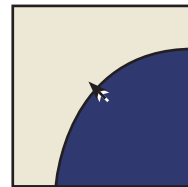
Light Background Block should measure $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make sixteen Light Background Blocks.

You will not use all of the Light Background Units.



Make four.



Make twelve.

With right sides facing, layer a Dark Background Unit with a Light Pie Unit. Match centers and pin.

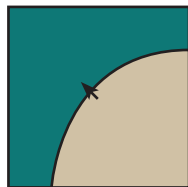
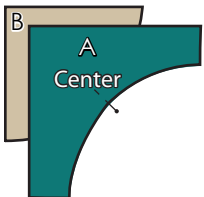
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With the Pie Section on the bottom, stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the edge of the Dark Background Unit. Be careful when stretching the bias edges.

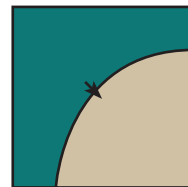
Dark Background Block should measure $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make twenty Dark Background Blocks.

You will not use all of the Light Pie Units.



Make fourteen.



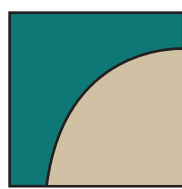
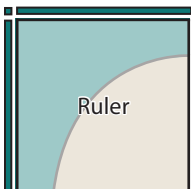
Make six.

Trim the Dark Background Blocks and the Light Background Blocks to 9 " x 9 ".

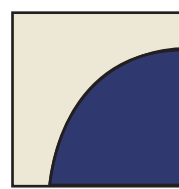
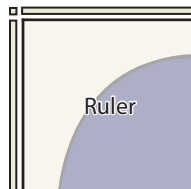
Make twenty Dark Background Blocks.

Make sixteen Light Background Blocks.

Make thirty-six total.

Make sixteen.

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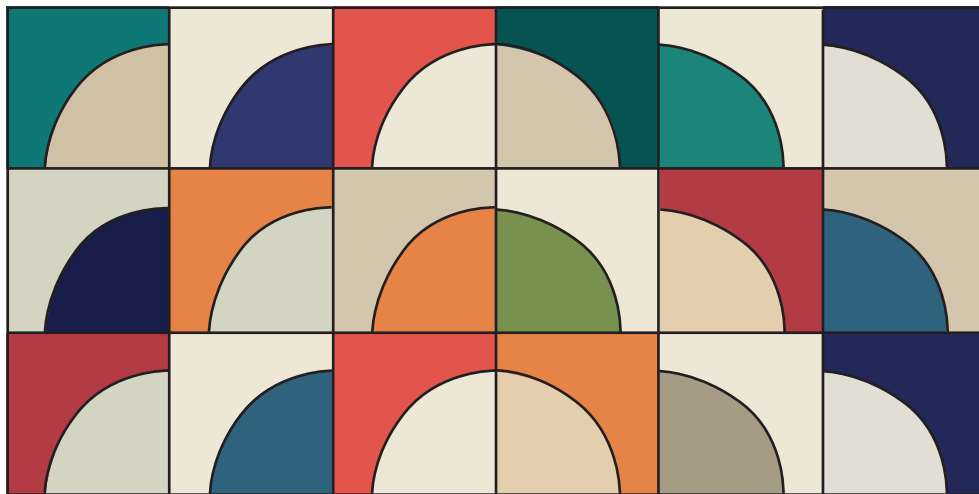
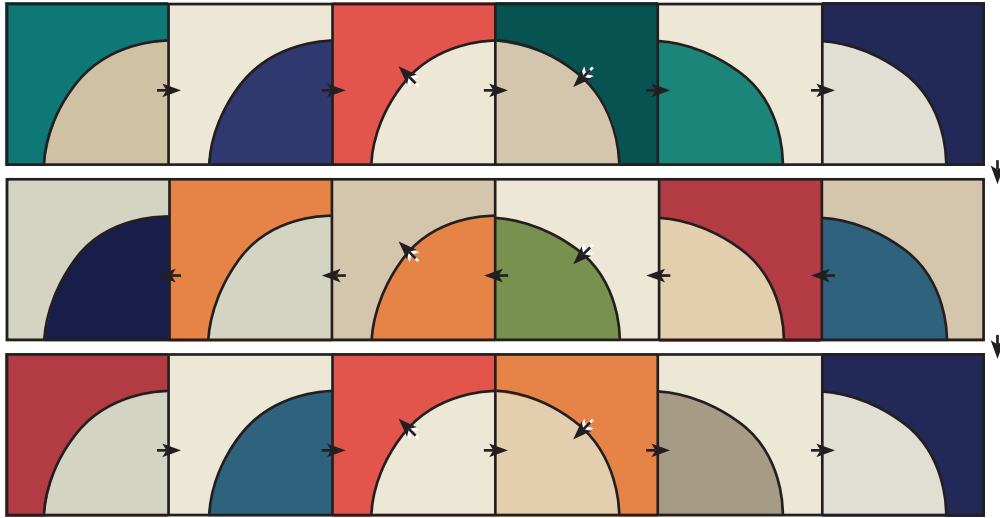
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Daybreak Section:

Assemble ten Dark Background Blocks and eight Light Background Blocks.

Daybreak Section should measure 26" x 51 1/2".

Make two.



Make two.

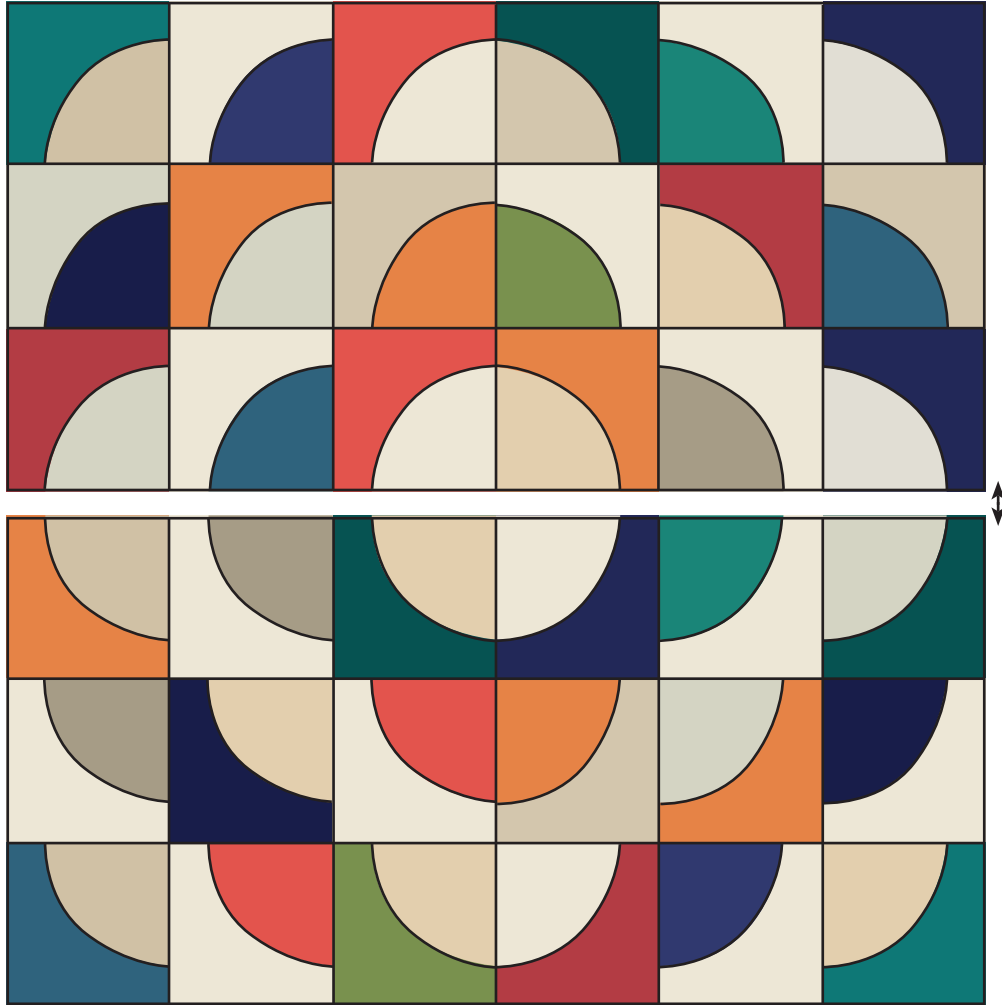
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Quilt Center:

Assemble the Quilt Center.

Quilt Center should measure 51 1/2" x 51 1/2".



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Borders:

Piece the Fabric C strips end to end.

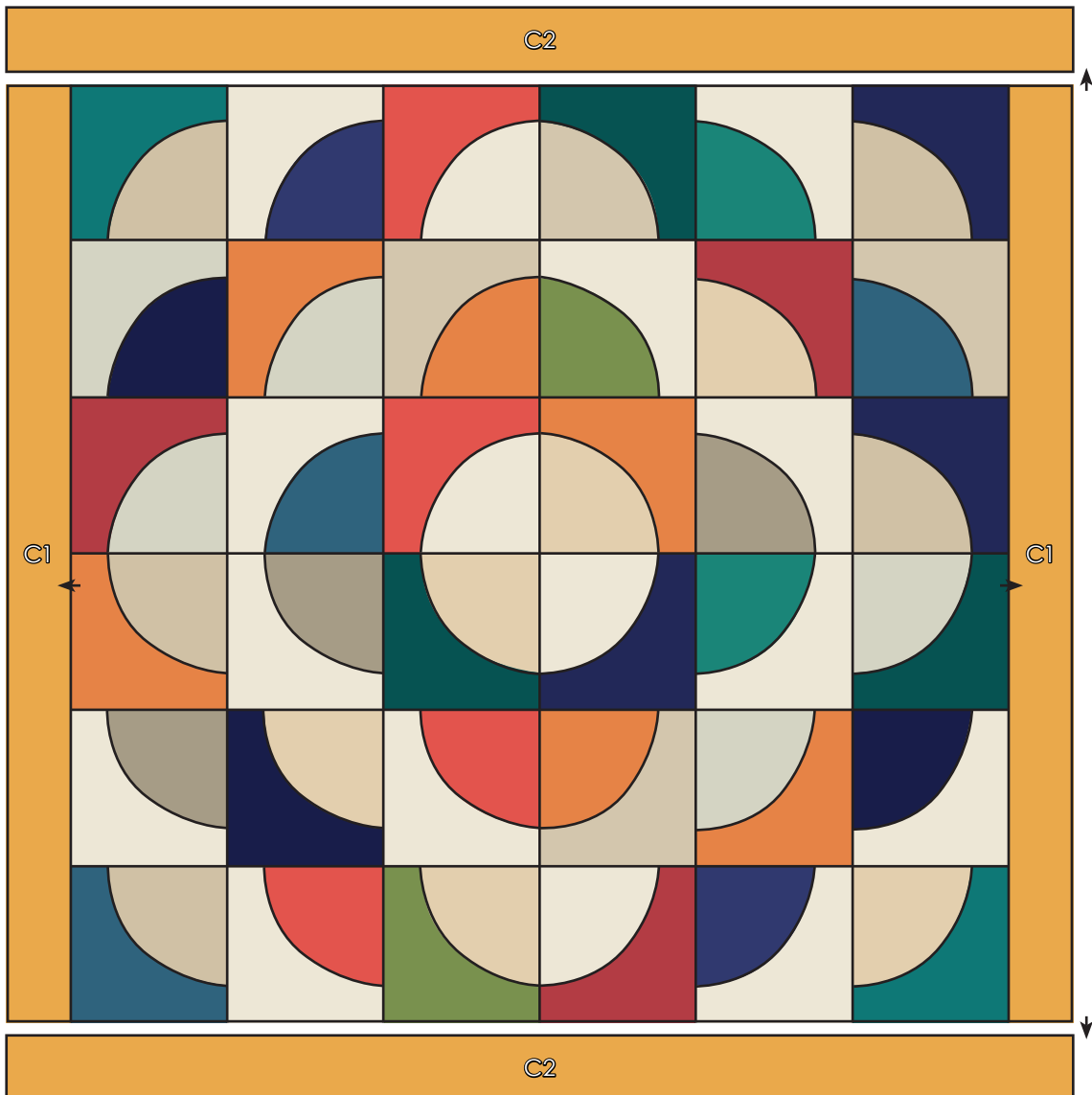
Subcut into:

2 - 4" x 51 1/2" strips (C1 - Side Borders)

2 - 4" x 58 1/2" strips (C2 - Top and Bottom Borders)

Attach Side Borders.

Attach Top and Bottom Borders.



Finishing:

Piece the Fabric D strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.
