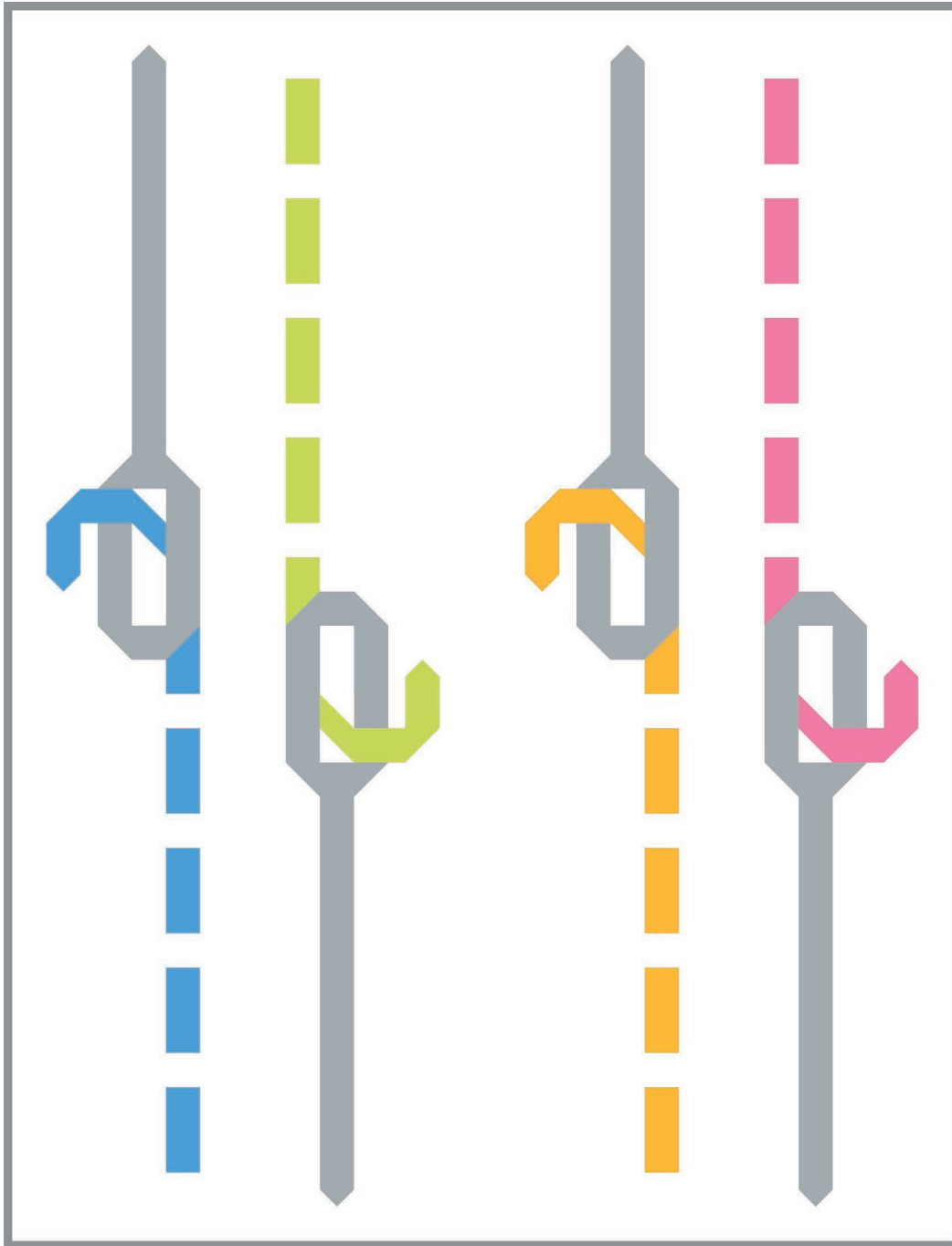



Stitch Quilt

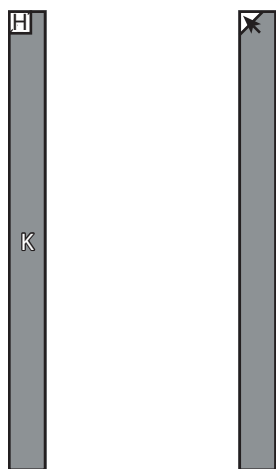
Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

Stitch Block:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric H squares.

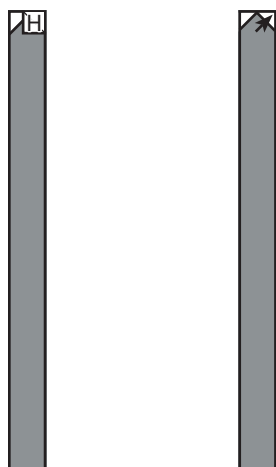
With right sides facing, layer a Fabric H square on the top left corner of a Fabric K rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.



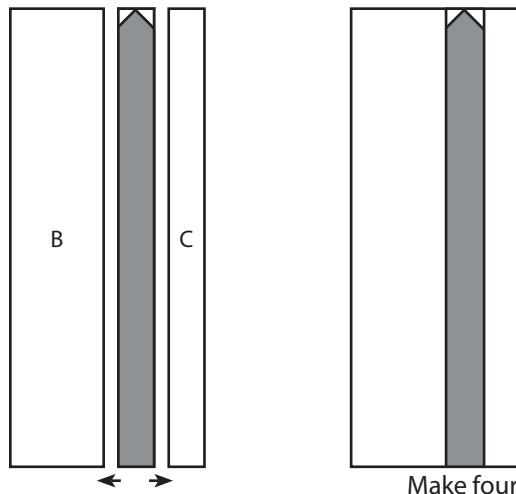
Repeat on the top right corner.

Partial Needle Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 24 1/2".



Assemble one Fabric B rectangle, one Partial Needle Unit and one Fabric C rectangle.

Needle Unit should measure 9 1/2" x 24 1/2".



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of twenty-four Fabric F squares.

With right sides facing, layer a marked Fabric F square on one end of a Fabric M rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.



Repeat on the opposite end.

Partial Top Needle Eye Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 6 1/2".



Assemble one Fabric E rectangle and one Partial Top Needle Eye Unit.

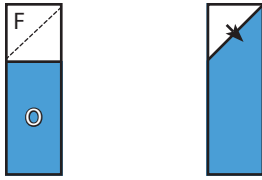
Top Needle Eye Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 9 1/2".



Stitch Quilt

With right sides facing, layer a marked Fabric F square on the top end of a Fabric O rectangle.

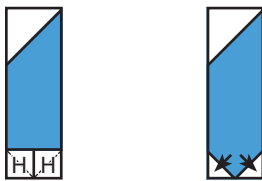
Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Make four total.

Repeat on the bottom corners with two Fabric H squares.

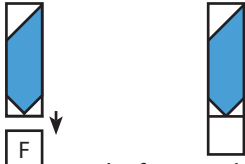
Partial Thread End Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make four total.

Assemble one Partial Thread End Unit and one Fabric F square.

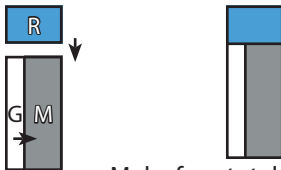
Thread End Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make four total.

Assemble one Fabric G rectangle, one Fabric M rectangle and one Fabric R rectangle.

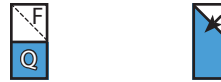
Left Needle Eye Unit should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make four total.

With right sides facing, layer a marked Fabric F square on one end of a Fabric Q rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Make four total.

Repeat on the opposite end.

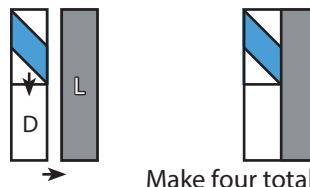
Center Thread Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make four total.

Assemble one Center Thread Unit, one Fabric D rectangle and one Fabric L rectangle.

Right Needle Eye Unit should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make four total.

Assemble one Thread End Unit, one matching Left Needle Eye Unit and one matching Right Needle Eye Unit.

Middle Needle Eye Unit should measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make four total.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one Fabric S square from each Fat Quarter.

With right sides facing, layer a marked Fabric F square on the left side of a Fabric M rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Make four total.

Repeat on the right side with a marked Fabric S square.

Partial Bottom Needle Eye Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Make four total.

Stitch Quilt

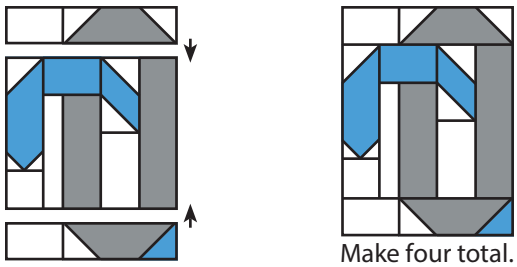
Assemble one Fabric E rectangle and one Partial Bottom Needle Eye Unit.

Bottom Needle Eye Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$.



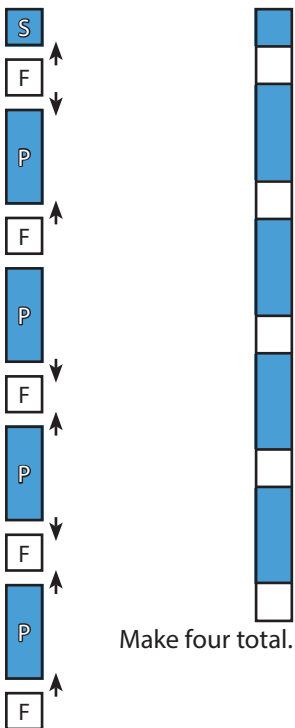
Assemble one Top Needle Eye Unit, one Middle Needle Eye Unit and one matching Bottom Needle Eye Unit.

Needle Eye Unit should measure $9\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$.



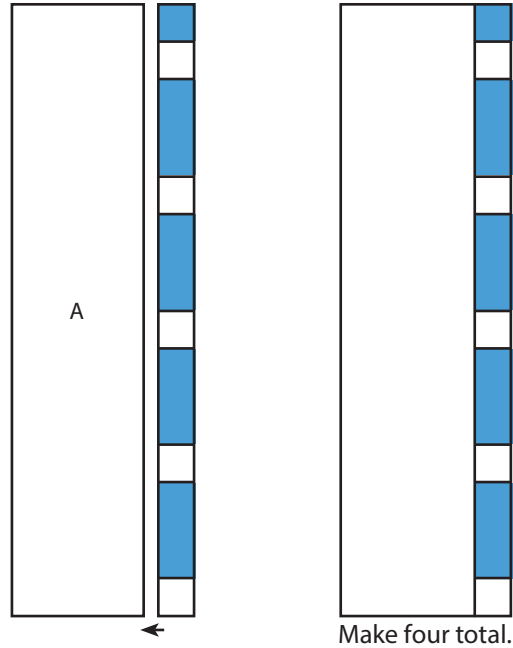
Assemble one Fabric S square, five Fabric F squares and four matching Fabric P rectangles.

Partial Stitch Line Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 32\frac{1}{2}''$.



Assemble one Fabric A strip and one Partial Stitch Line Unit.

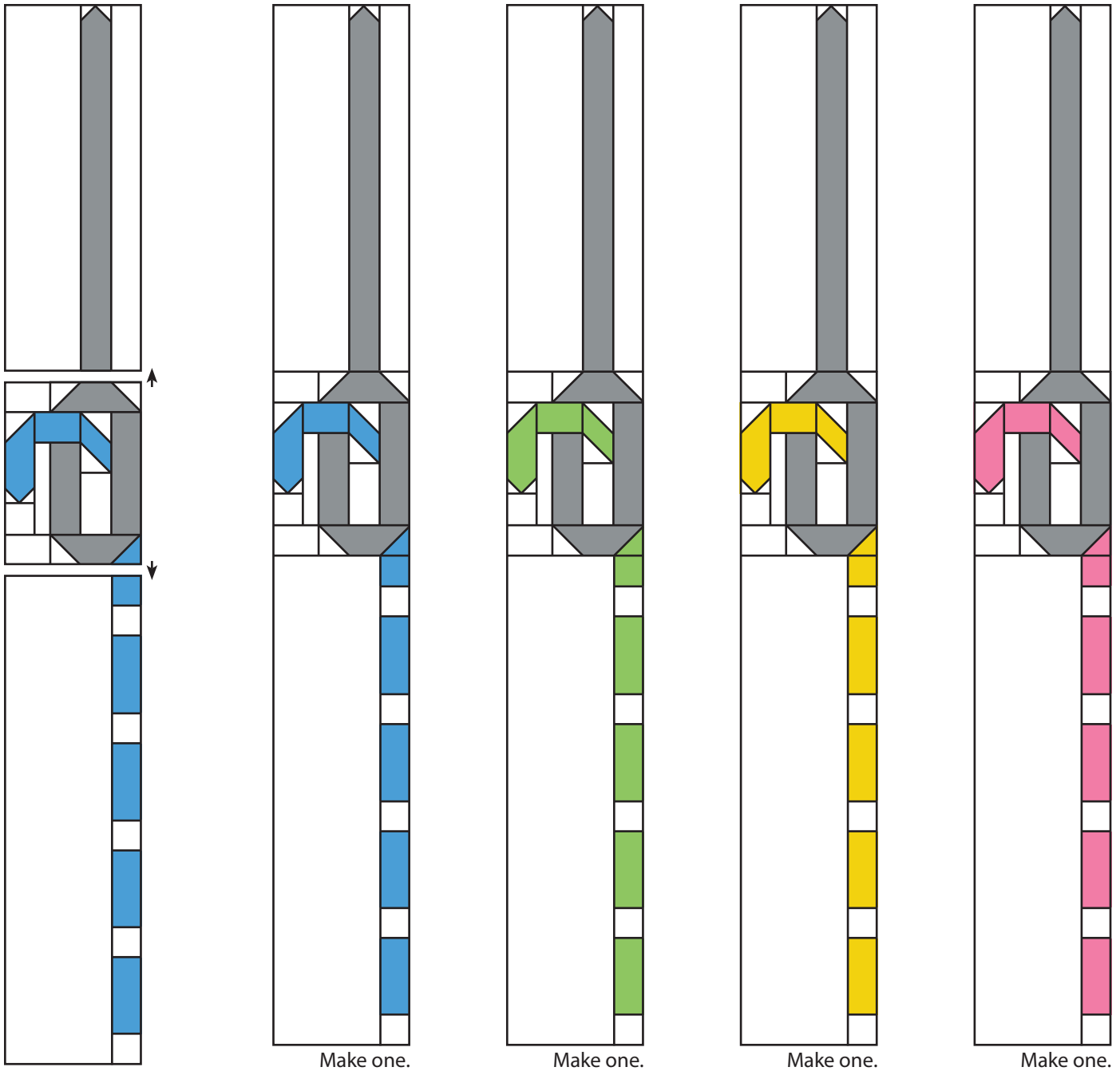
Stitch Line Unit should measure $9\frac{1}{2}'' \times 32\frac{1}{2}''$.



Stitch Quilt

Assemble one Needle Unit, one Needle Eye Unit and one matching Stitch Line Unit.

Stitch Block should measure $9\frac{1}{2}'' \times 68\frac{1}{2}''$.



Stitch Quilt

Quilt Center:

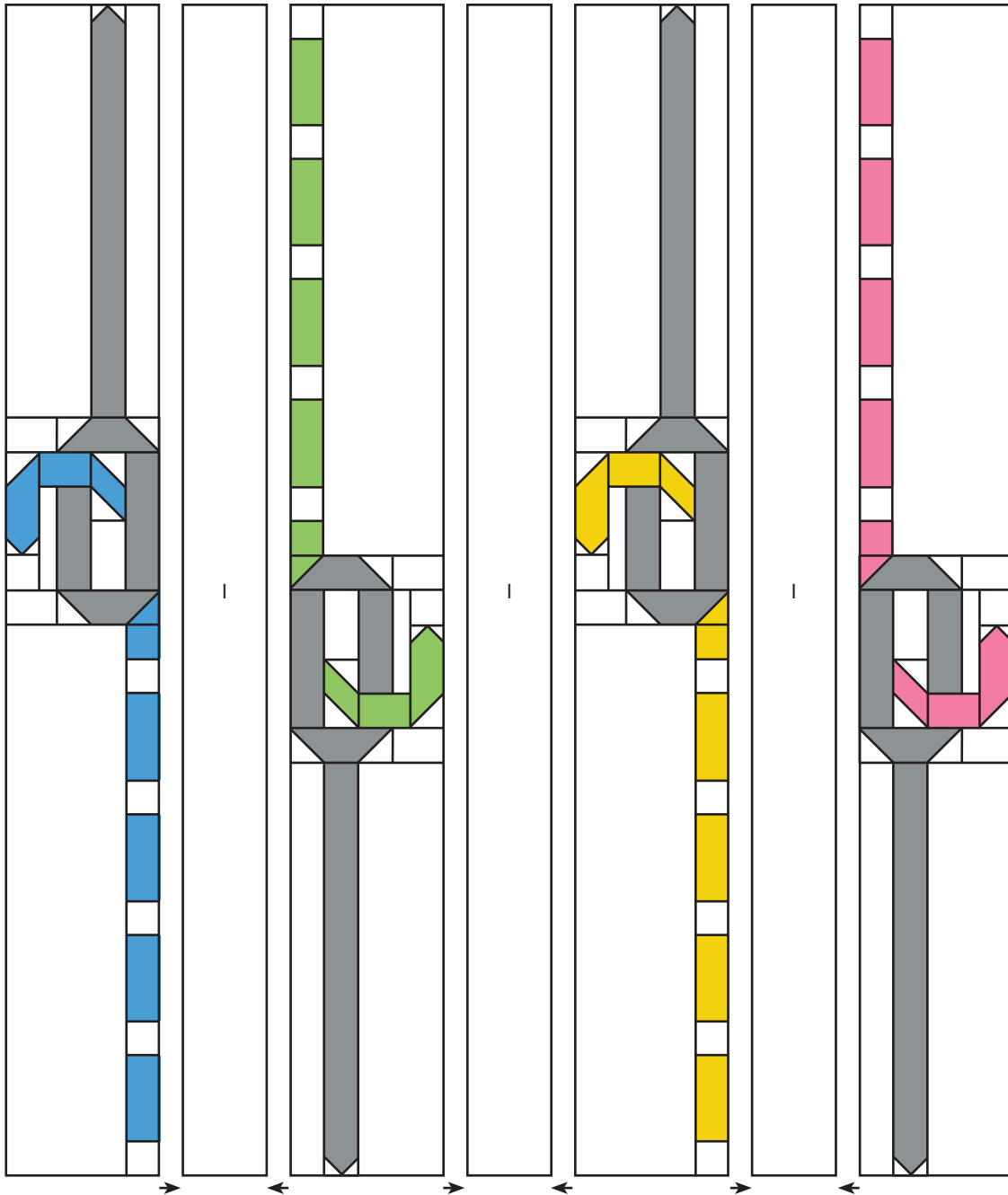
Piece the Fabric I strips end to end.

Subcut into:

3 - 5 1/2" x 68 1/2" strips (Sashing)

Assemble the Quilt Center.

Quilt Center should measure 51 1/2" x 68 1/2".



Stitch Quilt

Borders:

Piece the Fabric J strips end to end.

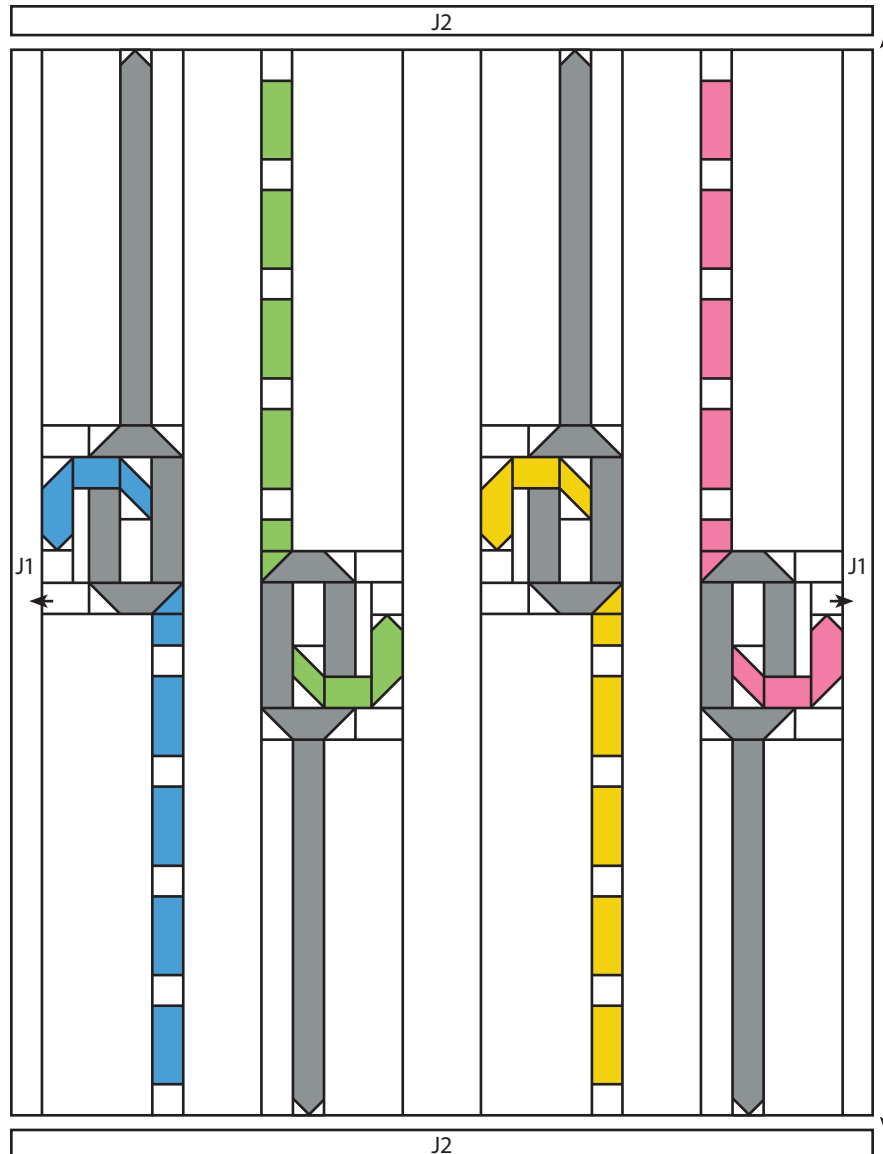
Subcut into:

2 - 2 1/2" x 68 1/2" strips (Side Borders - J1)

2 - 2 1/2" x 55 1/2" strips (Top and Bottom Borders - J2)

Attach Side Borders.

Attach Top and Bottom Borders.



Finishing:

Piece the Fabric N strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.
