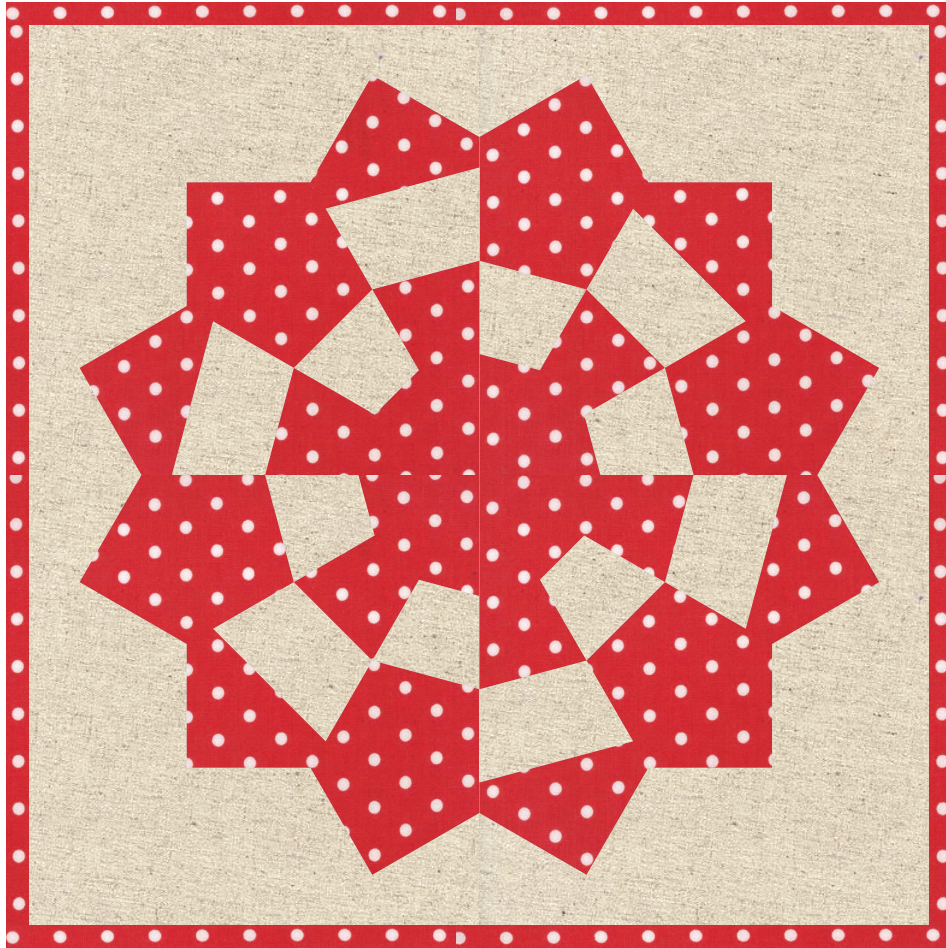



Flurry Pillow

Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

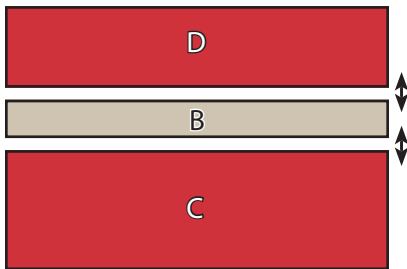
Flurry Block:

Refer to the Creative Grids Starburst Ruler YouTube video for tips on how to make a perfect Flurry Block.

Assemble one Fabric D strip, one Fabric B strip and one Fabric C strip.

Strip Set should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20".

Make two.

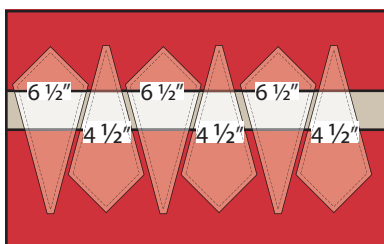
Line up the $6\frac{1}{2}$ " line on the Starburst Ruler with the top seam on the Strip Set.

Cut one $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Petal Unit and then turn the Starburst Ruler upside down.

Line up the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " line on the Starburst Ruler with the bottom seam on the Strip Set.

Cut one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Petal Unit and repeat.

Cut three $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Petal Units and three $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Petal Units from each strip.

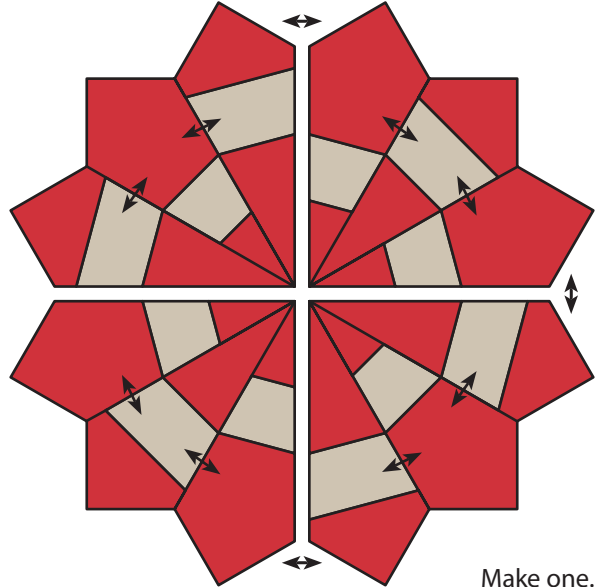


Make six $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Petals.

Make six $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Petals.

Assemble the Flurry Unit.

Make one Flurry Unit.



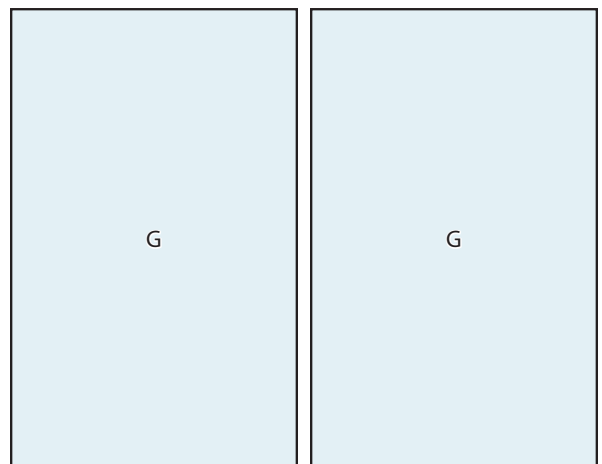

Pillow Center:

Assemble two Fabric G rectangles.

Pellon Unit should measure 24" x $29\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make one.

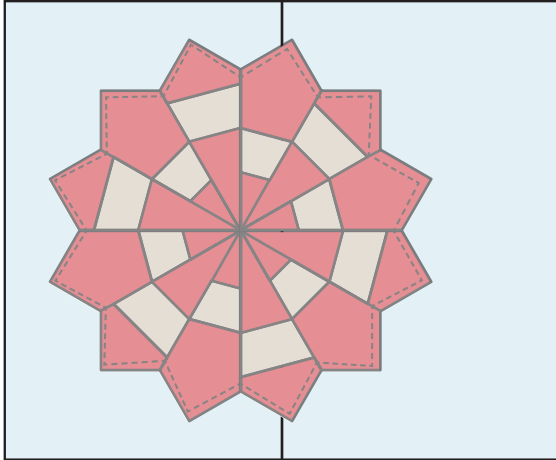
Flurry Pillow

With right sides facing, layer the Flurry Unit with the Pellon Unit.

Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam sew around the entire Flurry Unit.

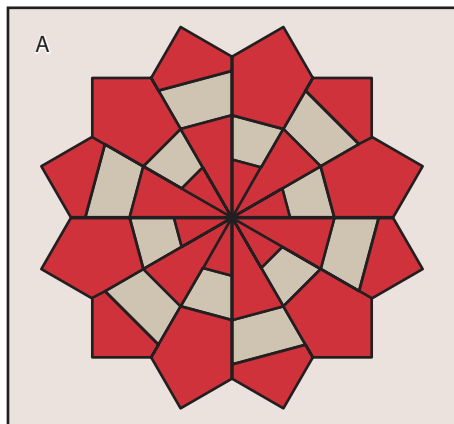
Trim the excess Pellon by cutting around the Flurry Unit.

Trim the tips $\frac{1}{8}$ " away from the seam.



Cut a 4" slit in the Pellon and turn the Flurry Unit right side out.

Using your preferred applique method, attach the Flurry Unit to the Fabric A square.



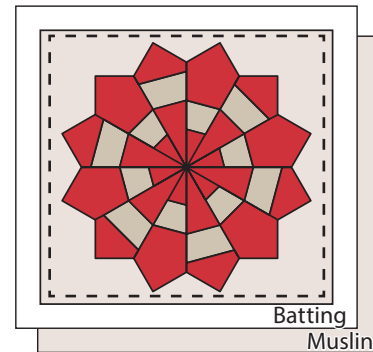
Pillow Top:

Layer Pillow Top, Batting and Muslin.

Quilt Pillow Top as desired.

Baste $\frac{1}{8}$ " around outside edges of the Pillow Top.

Trim excess Batting and Muslin.

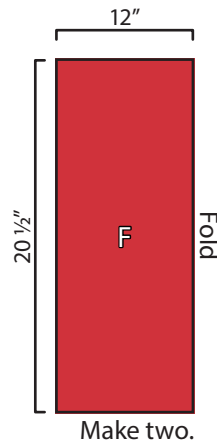


Pillow Back:

With wrong sides facing, fold one Fabric F rectangle in half.

Folded Fabric F Unit should measure 12" x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make two.



Flurry Pillow

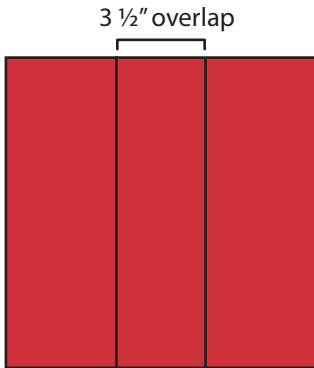
Pillow Assembly:

Layer two Folded Fabric H Units and overlap them $3\frac{1}{2}$ " with folds in the center and raw edges on the outside.

Pin around the edges.

Baste $\frac{1}{8}$ " around the edges of the Pillow Back.

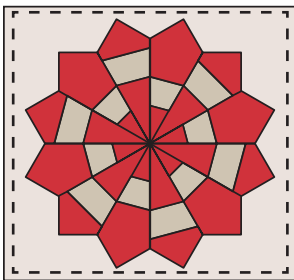
Pillow Back should measure $20\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Mark the center of the Pillow Top and mark the center of the Pillow Back. Matching centers, layer the Pillow Top right side up on the Pillow Back.

Baste $\frac{1}{8}$ " around the edges to hold the Pillow Top and Pillow Back together.

Trim the excess backing.



Finishing:

Piece the Fabric E strips end to end for binding.

Bind as desired.
