

Download Twenty-One - Quilty Fun Sampler Label

Finished size: 16" x 16"



Cutting Instructions

From background fabric ($\frac{7}{8}$ yard):

* Cut 1	6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle	Fabric A
* Cut 1	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle	Fabric B
* Cut 2	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles	Fabric C
* Cut 1	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle	Fabric D
* Cut 1	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square	Fabric E
* Cut 4	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares	Fabric F
* Cut 6	1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares	Fabric G
* Cut 1	16 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square	Fabric H

From green fabric for bonnet ribbon ($\frac{1}{4}$ yard):

* Cut 1	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle	Fabric I
* Cut 3	1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares	Fabric J

From yellow scrappy fabrics for bonnet:

* Cut 4	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares	Fabric K
* Cut 9	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares	Fabric L
* Cut 3	1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares	Fabric M

From 10" x 10" navy fabric for bonnet bow:

* Cut 4	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares	Fabric N
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Quilty Fun Sew Along Companion Sheet

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Bonnet Block:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric F squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric F square with a Fabric K square.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.

Fabric F/K Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make four.



Assemble two Fabric F/K Units and four Fabric L squares.

Bonnet Rim Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make one.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric G squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric G square on the top left corner of a Fabric N square.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the bottom left and right corners of the Fabric N square.

Fabric G/N Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make two.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric J squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric J square on the top left corner of a Fabric N square.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the bottom left and right corners of the Fabric N square.

Fabric J/N Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make one.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric M squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric M square on the top left corner of a Fabric N square.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the bottom left and right corners of the Fabric N square.

Fabric M/N Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make one.



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Assemble two Fabric F/K Units, two Fabric L squares and the Fabric E square.

Bonnet Top Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 10 1/2".

Make one.



Assemble three Fabric L squares, the Fabric M/N Unit and one Fabric G/N Unit.

Bonnet Middle Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 10 1/2".

Make one.



Assemble the Fabric I rectangle, the Fabric J/N Unit and one Fabric G/N Unit.

Bonnet Ribbon Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 10 1/2".

Make one.



Assemble the Bonnet Top Unit, the Bonnet Middle Unit and the Bonnet Ribbon Unit.

Bonnet Crown Unit should measure 6 1/2" x 10 1/2".

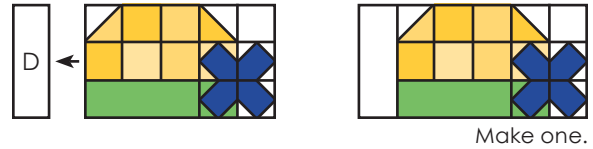
Make one.



Assemble the Fabric D rectangle and the Bonnet Crown Unit.

Fabric D/Bonnet Crown Unit should measure 6 1/2" x 12 1/2".

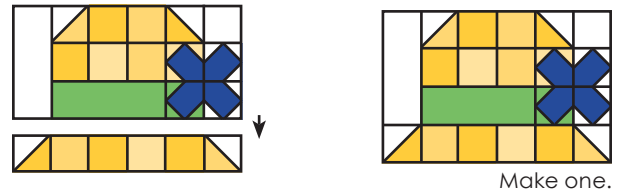
Make one.



Assemble the Fabric D/Bonnet Crown Unit and the Bonnet Rim Unit.

Bonnet Unit should measure 8 1/2" x 12 1/2".

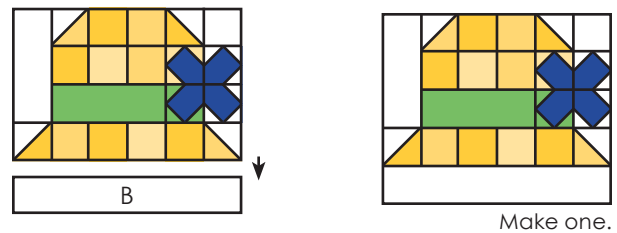
Make one.



Assemble Bonnet Unit and the Fabric B rectangle.

Bonnet/Fabric B Unit should measure 10 1/2" x 12 1/2".

Make one.



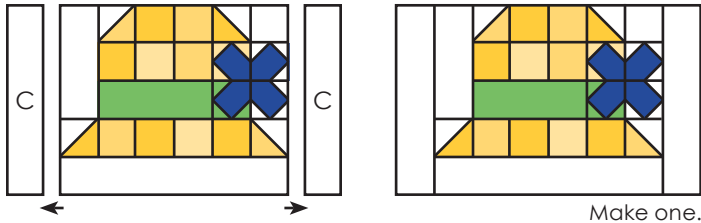
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Assemble two Fabric C rectangles and the Bonnet/Fabric B Unit.

Bonnet Block Unit should measure 10 1/2" x 16 1/2".

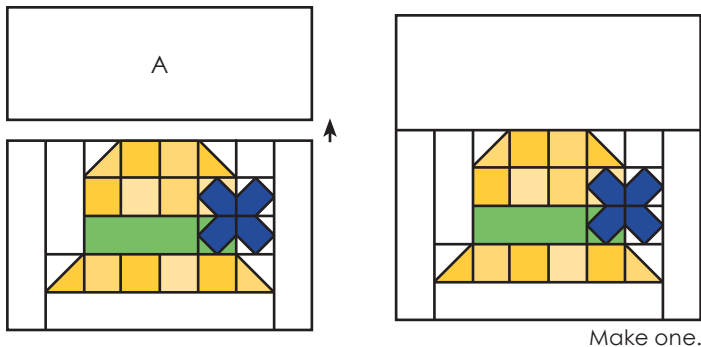
Make one.



Assemble the Fabric A rectangle and the Bonnet Block Unit.

Bonnet Block should measure 16 1/2" x 16 1/2".

Make one.



Embroidery:

To add the words and bee to the label, use the template on page 5. Trace the words and bee onto the space above the bonnet for embroidery.

Use two strands of embroidery floss and a backstitch.

With right sides facing, layer the Bonnet Quilt Label with the Fabric H rectangle.

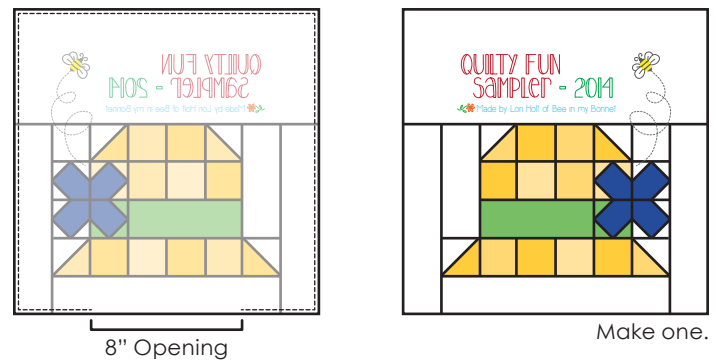
Stitch around the Bonnet Quilt Label using a 1/4" seam. Leave an 8" opening at the bottom.

Turn the Bonnet Quilt Label right side out.

Press the opening edges under 1/4" and hand stitch the bottom closed.

The Bonnet Quilt Label should measure 16" x 16".

Make one.



Attaching the Label:

Pin the Bonnet Quilt Label 10 to 12 inches from the side and bottom of the Quilty Fun Sampler Quilt Backing, leaving plenty of room for the longarm quilter to put it on their longarm frame without bothering the label.

Use a whip stitch to sew the Bonnet Quilt Label to the backing.
