

Download One - Filled Basket Block

Finished Size: 11 1/2" x 15 1/2"

Cutting Instructions:

From 1/3 yard of white background fabric:

- Cut 2 Fabric B
- Cut 2 Fabric C
- Cut 2 Fabric D
- Cut 2 Fabric E
- Cut 4 Fabric F
- Cut 2 Fabric G
- Cut 8 Fabric H
- Cut 1 Fabric I
- Cut 2 2" x 2 1/2" rectangles *
- Cut 4 1 1/2" squares *
- Cut 1 1" x 7 1/2" rectangle *
- Cut 2 1" x 4 1/2" rectangles *

From a fat quarter of pink fabric for basket base:

- Cut 1 Fabric N
- Cut 1 Fabric O

From 1/8 yard of red fabric for basket handle and trim:

- Cut 1 Fabric P
- Cut 2 Fabric Q
- Cut 4 Fabric R
- Cut 1 Fabric S

From 1/8 yard of blue fabric for basket bow:

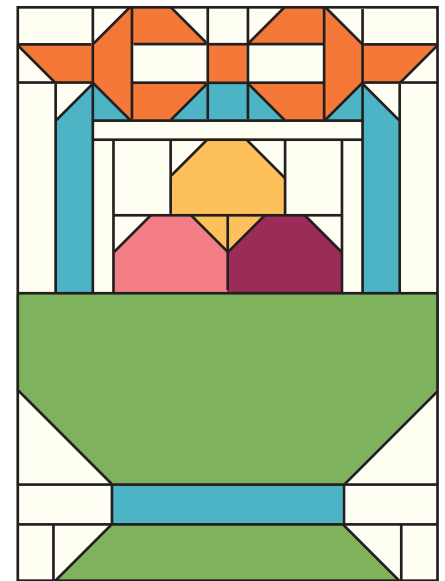
- Cut 2 Fabric T
- Cut 6 Fabric U
- Cut 1 Fabric V

From 2 scrappy fabrics for the bottom yarn balls:

- Cut 1 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle (2 total) *

From 1 scrappy fabric for the top yarn ball:

- Cut 1 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle *
- Cut 2 1 1/2" squares *



Make one.

Piecing instructions begin on page 10 of *Great Granny Squared!*

* Stacked Yarn Unit replaces Fabric A. Refer to page 2 for instructions.

GG Squared Companion Sheet (Mama's Crochet Quilt)

Stacked Yarn Unit:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 1 1/2" white background squares.

With right sides facing, layer a 1 1/2" white background square on the top left corner of the 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" scrappy fabric rectangle for the Top Yarn Unit.

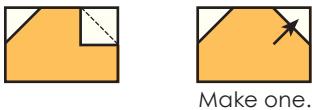
Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.



Repeat on the top right corner of the 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" scrappy fabric rectangle.

Top Yarn Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 3 1/2".

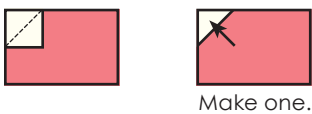
Make one.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 1 1/2" scrappy squares.

With right sides facing, layer a 1 1/2" white background square on the top left corner of the 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" scrappy fabric rectangle for the Left Yarn Unit.

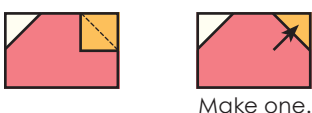
Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.



Repeat on the top right corner of the 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" scrappy fabric rectangle with a 1 1/2" scrappy square.

Left Yarn Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 3 1/2".

Make one.



With right sides facing, layer a 1 1/2" scrappy square on the top left corner of the 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" scrappy fabric rectangle for the Right Yarn Unit.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.



Repeat on the top right corner of the 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" scrappy fabric rectangle with a 1 1/2" white background square.

Right Yarn Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 3 1/2".

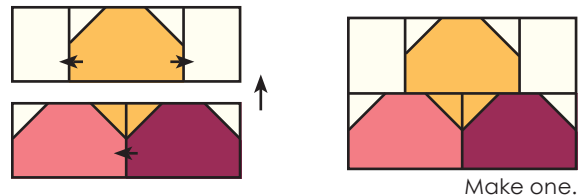
Make one.



Assemble two 2" x 2 1/2" white background rectangles, the Top Yarn Unit, the Left Yarn Unit and the Right Yarn Unit.

Three Yarn Unit should measure 4 1/2" x 6 1/2".

Make one.



Attach side borders using the 1" x 4 1/2" white background rectangles.

Attach top border using the 1" x 7 1/2" white background rectangle.

Stacked Yarn Unit should measure 5" x 7 1/2".

Make one.
