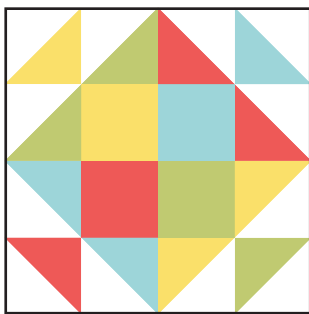
### Fabric Requirements:

- Background: 1 yard
- Bright Futures Variation Block: 4 Fat Eighths
- Block Background: Fat Quarter
- Accent: 1 yard
- Binding: 1/2 yard
- Backing: 1 1/4 yards

### Bright Futures Variation Block Cutting:

Block Background	4	A
Bright Futures Units	<i>From each print cut:</i>	
	1 (4 total)	B
	1 (4 total)	C
3" Finished Half Square Triangle Paper #H300	4 - two by one sections (2 squares each)	





### Finishing Cutting:

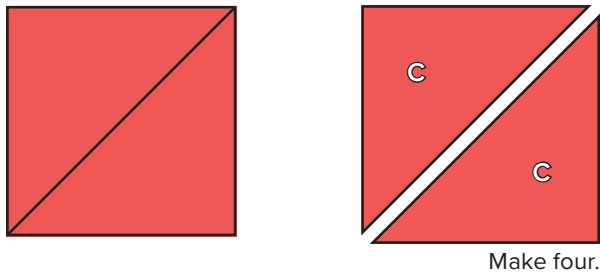
Background	4 - 9" x 17 1/2" rectangles	A
	4 - 9" squares	B
Accent	2 - 9 1/2" squares	C
	8 - 9" squares	D
Binding	5 - 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips	E



Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

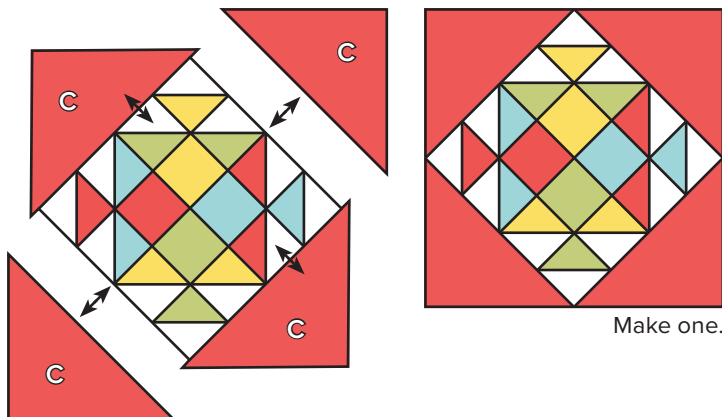
### Block Finishing:

Cut the Fabric C squares on the diagonal once.



Assemble Block.

**Trim** Center Block to measure 17 1/2" x 17 1/2".



### Borders:

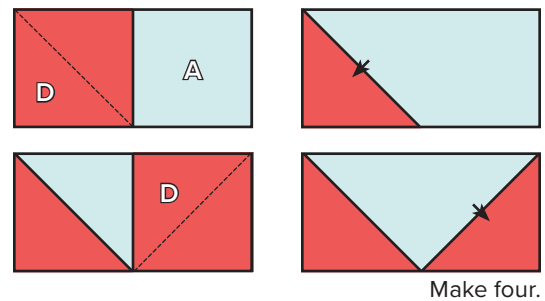
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric D squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric D square on one end of a Fabric A rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.

Repeat on the opposite end.

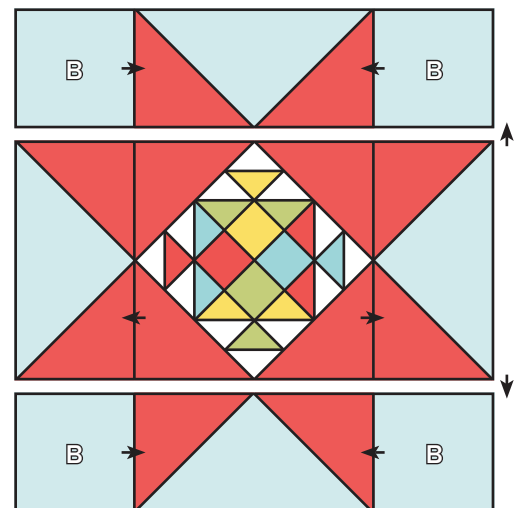
Flying Geese Unit should measure 9" x 17 1/2".



### Quilt Center:

Assemble Quilt Center.

Quilt Center should measure 34 1/2" x 34 1/2".



### Finishing:

Piece the Fabric E strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.
