Use $\ensuremath{\mathcal{W}}$ " seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

Bird Block Assembly:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric K squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric K square on the left end of the Fabric T rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.

Repeat on the right end.

Partial Head Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 6 1/2".











Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric S square.

With right sides facing, layer the Fabric S square on the bottom left corner of the Fabric U rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.

Face Unit should measure 2 ½" x 4 ½".





Make one.

Assemble the Fabric R square, the Face Unit and the Partial Head Unit.

Head Unit should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".





Assemble the Fabric F square, one Fabric V rectangle and one Fabric J rectangle.



Beak Unit should measure 3 ½" x 6 ½".



Assemble the Fabric A rectangle, the Head Unit and the Beak Unit.

Top Unit should measure 6 ½" x 17 ½".



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric C squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric C square on the top end of the Fabric Q rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.

Repeat on the bottom end.

Feather Unit should measure 5 ½" x 7 ½".










Make one.

Assemble the Fabric B rectangle and the Feather Unit. Left Side Unit should measure $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $16 \frac{1}{2}$ ".








Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric E square.


With right sides facing, layer the Fabric E square on the top left corner of the Fabric P square.


Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.


Repeat on the top right corner with a Fabric K square and the bottom right corner with a Fabric C square.

Body Unit should measure 11 ½" x 11 ½".









Assemble the Fabric N rectangle, one Fabric V rectangle, one Fabric J rectangle, the Fabric X square, the Fabric O square and the Fabric W rectangle.


Foot Unit should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".






Assemble the Fabric I rectangle, the Foot Unit, the Fabric D rectangle and the Fabric M rectangle.


Bottom Right Unit should measure 5 ½" x 11 ½".






Assemble Block.

Bird Block should measure 17 1/2" x 22 1/2".





Inner Borders:


Attach side inner borders using the Fabric G strips. Attach top and bottom inner borders using the Fabric H strips.



Outer Borders:

Attach side outer borders using the Fabric Z strips.

Attach top and bottom outer borders using the Fabric Y strips.



Finishing:

Piece the Fabric AA strips end to end for binding. Quilt and bind as desired.
