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## Use $1 / 4$ " seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

## Block Assembly:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric A squares.
With right sides facing, layer a Fabric A square with a Fabric C square.
Stitch $1 / 4$ " from each side of the drawn line.
Cut apart on the marked line.
Half Square Triangle Unit should measure $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 61 / 2$ ".

Cut the Fabric B squares on the diagonal once.


Make sixteen.

Assemble two Fabric E squares and two Fabric F squares.
Four Patch Unit should measure $43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4$ ".


Assemble four Fabric B triangles and one Four Patch Unit.
Trim Richmond Unit to measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Make four.
